Uniforms and Appearance

Please send your children to school showered, well-groomed, and in dress code.

All students are now required to wear a clean face shield or facial covering to school. Facial coverings can be any color or design as long as they are school appropriate, and they do not distract from learning.

Tops

DePaul School colors are orange, royal blue/navy blue, and white. Purchase our polo shirts with the DePaul School insignia through RC Uniform Store on Beach Blvd (Please note: you can shop via website, too. Some colors may not be available. If you cannot locate shirts in the DePaul colors, please request assistance directly from RC Uniforms. Also, it takes time for RC Uniform store to embroider the shirts. A solid white t-shirt (long or short sleeved) with no logo may be worn under the polo in cooler weather. Polos must be tucked in with waistband visible. Students may wear last year's uniforms if those items still fit. We will provide a dress down tee for Fridays.

Pants, Shorts, Skirts, and Jumpers

Our uniform has appropriately-fitting khaki or navy standard length dress pants. We do not allow cargo pants, cargo shorts, or clearly-visible undies. Students may also wear khaki or navy standard length (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee) shorts, skirts, and jumpers.

These may come from any retailer as long as they fit the DePaul dress code.

Hoodies and sweatshirts must be official DePaul uniform hoodies and sweatshirts.

Belts

Belts are OPTIONAL. Belts are undecorated black, navy, brown or khaki, with a plain belt buckle.

Shoes

Students must wear closed-toed shoes with laces tied at all times. Some students are permitted to wear open shoes under special conditions with permission from administration.

Socks

Solid navy, khaki, or white socks must be worn at all times. Students may wear solid navy or white tights in colder weather.

Hair

Hair should be clean, well groomed, and away from the face and out of the eyes. We allow natural hair colors only, with exceptions for Character Day or Red Ribbon Week.

Jewelry

We allow small earrings in each ear. For safety reasons, no dangly earrings are permitted. Necklaces may be worn if tucked inside the shirt. Bracelets, tattoos (permanent or temporary), and writing on skin are not permitted.

Fragrances

Please do not wear heavy fragrances, since many students are allergic. We highly encourage the use of deodorant.

DePaul Dress Down

On Fridays and the last school day before a holiday, we have dress-down days. Students may wear their DePaul dress-down T-shirts and appropriately-fitting clean jeans with no holes, tears or inappropriate writing or designs.

Administration reserves the right to interpret what might constitute a distraction and ensure compliance with the rules stated above.

Please do not repeatedly request non-medical exceptions to the dress code.

We also ask that students not wear items that distract them or other students from learning, unless it is a special occasion (Red Ribbon Week, Character Day, etc.).

If you need a medical exception to the dress code, please let us know.

On the student's birthday, or the school day closest to the student's birthday, he/she may wear "street clothes" appropriate for school. Occasionally students will earn this treat as an incentive or a reward.
